

PROTECTION OF PROCESS: COUPLES COUNSELING

This is an agreement between individuals in a couples counseling setting stating that neither party shall for any reason attempt to subpoena my testimony or my records to be presented in a deposition or court hearing of any kind for any reason, such as a divorce case.

Counseling participants acknowledge that the goal of psychotherapy is for the sole purpose of decreasing psychological distress and increasing resources and that the process of psychotherapy depends on trust and openness during the therapy sessions.

Therefore it is understood by both parties that if they request my services as a psychotherapist, they are expected not to use information shared during the therapy process against the other party in a judicial setting of any kind, be it civil, criminal, or circuit.
